

Floating Shelf Instructions

Free Standing Floating Shelf

1. Use a stud finder to check where the studs are located, making a light pencil mark on the wall to identify the location.
2. Using a level, draw a light line with a pencil across the wall to ensure that your shelf will be straight.
3. Align your bracket to the marking on your wall, then attach it, making sure the screw hits the stud.
4. Slide shelf onto bracket. We recommend that you screw the shelf onto the bracket at the top and bottom for extra support.



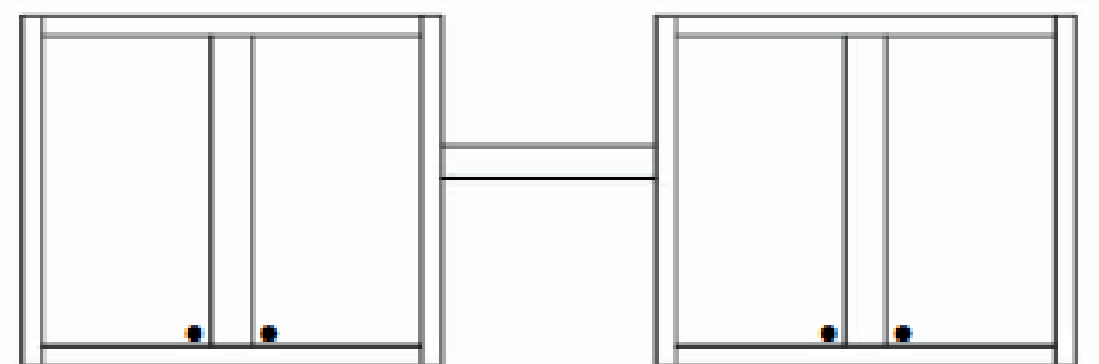
Please Note:
The mounting plate is shorter to allow for shifting (left or right) of the floating shelf.



***Number of metal brackets will vary according to size.**

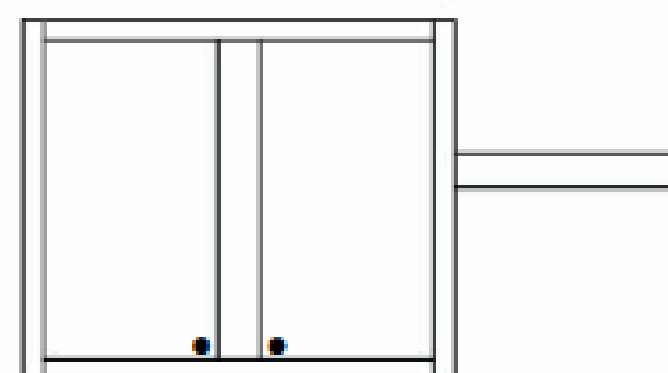
Floating Shelf Between Two Cabinets

1. Attach the shelf bracket to the wall between the two cabinets.
2. Slide shelf onto the shelf bracket.
3. For extra support you can screw the shelf bracket to the cabinet (from the inside of the cabinet).



Floating Shelf Attached To One Cabinet

1. Attach the shelf bracket to the wall.
2. Slide shelf onto the shelf bracket.
3. For extra support you can screw the shelf bracket to the cabinet (from the inside of the cabinet).
